



Cotswold Enduro Club Rules 2023

- All riders need an AMCA licence you can use your AMCA MX, Trials or Classic Scrambles licence at our events to. A Year Licence is £20 and can be download from our website (Or available at the events for £25)
 - Or you can apply directly to the AMCA. A day licence is available for £10 per event
- NO PHOTOGRAPHERS allowed at our events
- No tear offs at any of our events
- **Helmets** must be worn at all times on the way to scrutineering, to the start line & back to your van after the race
- No rider is to allow anyone associated with them on the back of their bikes at any of our events
- You will be asked at each event to assist in the helping to take the track down. This will be done in classes and will be announced on the day
- All members are automatically entered into the Cotswold Enduro Club Championship incorporating "The Porter 400 Series" but please be aware that non-Club Members will take the points away. Laps will be added as points and loyalty points of 5 will be added if at least 6 rounds of the 7 are ridden and will be added to the total end of year score. Trophies will be awarded at the end of the season
- Please adhere to all signs on the entrance to our venues
- Green & White or Black & Yellow tape means 5MPH at all times
- It is advisable to walk the track prior to the event
- **No pushbikes** are to be ridden around the track prior and during the event
- Children can ride pushbikes in the paddock or camping field but not on the track
- To finish you MUST be timed in to appear in the results
- In the event of a machine failure, you can only qualify for a finish if you cross the finish line by completing the course from where your machine failed. [A MACHINE MUST NOT BE TOWED IN OR TAKEN VIA A SHORTER ROUTE]
- **The Club reserves the right** to promote a rider to a higher class if he or she is riding above the standard for that class
- It is a RIDER'S responsibility to ensure that they have entered the CORRECT CLASS. Points CANNOT be moved from one class to another
- **Riders wishing to promote or demote** themselves can only do so with the permission of The Club Secretary and must be requested in writing
- **Riders finishing** 1st, 2nd or 3rd in a Championship will be promoted to the next highest-class next season, this includes up to 5th in Sportsman
- Riders will take the consequences of their own actions and of any persons associated with them
- **Pits and re-fuelling area** There must be no smoking, no children (under the age of 18) or dogs in the pits or refueling area. All engines must be switched off when re-fuelling. Failure to comply will result in the associated rider being extracted from the event
- Children & Dogs must be kept at a safe distance from the track side at least 30 feet at all times.
- Course cutting, excessive verbal & physical abuse WILL result in instant EXCLUSION from the event
- **Outside assistance** means under no circumstances should goggles / fuel / refreshments / maintenance & repairs be done trackside other than by the rider him / herself. Pit crew / helpers can only carry out the above-mentioned tasks in the designated areas. The only outside assistance given to the riders must be from an official / marshal and this only to a limited degree
- All riders must obey any orders given to them by Marshals and the Officials AT ALL TIMES
- Any complaints during the event MUST be voiced to the clerk of the course on the day or they will NOT be considered
- **The minimum age** to enter an Enduro is now 14. But from the ages of 14-16 you must complete a minor consent form and send off with a set of regs, this form is available on the website. If you are 16- 18 the normal booking procedure applies
- The Club Officials reserve the right to change the rules or add to them without notice
- **Noise** 94 decibels is the maximum noise level, this will be enforced on a regular basis failure to comply will result in exclusion from the event before, during and after. This is <u>your</u> responsibility. This is probably the biggest single issue, which is endangering our sport. If in doubt fit a standard pipe or a pipe that is guaranteed the certificated 94-decibel noise limit
- Any changes to the above rules will be discussed at the rider's meeting
- **Failure to comply** with the above rules will result at the very least the exclusion from the event or a possible ban from riding with the CEC in the future. These rules are there for very good reason
- Results remain provisional for 7 days anyone wishing to contest them must contact the Secretary
